We offer:

the possibility to work on exciting projects using state-of-the-art technologies in a stimulating, creative and international research environment. The projekt is funded by an Advanced ERC grant "Traitor-virus-guided discovery of antiviral factors". We have developed an innovative CRISPR approach for HIV-driven discovery of antiviral mechanisms (doi.org/10.1101/2023.11.03.565501) that offer exciting possibilities for further discovery. The project will be interdisciplinary and highly interactive. PhD students will have advanced training opportunities, such as provided according to the German TV-L system.

Required qualifications and skills:

- Master, Diploma or PhD in Molecular Medicine, Biology, Biochemistry, Bioinformatics or related subjects.
- Applicants driven by curiosity and a strong motivation for scientific research are preferred.

Projects topics:

- · innate immune defense mechanismus against viral pathogens
- adaption of immunodeficiency viruses to the human host
- identification of targets for preventive and therapeutic approaches
